

Seekonk Speedway Trailer races

Tow some fun around Seekonk

August 2nd 2009

The races will be held with teams using one vehicle hooked up to a trailer and another vehicle used as the defender. As the teams circle the track the object will be for the vehicles pulling the trailers to complete a selected number of laps with the trailer still hooked up to their vehicle. The defenders are used to try and knock the opponent's trailers loose and defend their own team's trailer.

Vehicles eligible for use most follow the same rules as for enduros, figure 8's & demo derbys also full size trucks and Mini vans can be used that follow the speedway rules for truck figure 8's.

Trailers:

Minimum trailer length -16' maximum -24'. Measurement is from tongue to trailing edge of trailer. Two or four wheel axles permitted.

Trailers can be campers, boats (Only steel or fiberglass with a FLAT nose) No pointed bows! and open deck trailers permitted.

Jack posts must swivel to horizontal position or be removed.

Open trailers need to have something in them that promote fun for all.

Each trailer will be judged for its starting spot. The more excitement each trailer brings to the fans will help the teams earn their starting spots up front.

Create a theme that makes your team a winner.

Trailer hitch VERY IMPORTANT standard type hitches 2-5/16" maximum ball size.

Double Safety Chains are MANDATORY.
